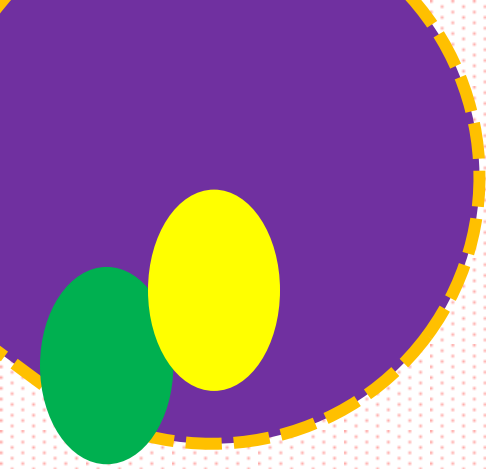

Homeless Prevention:

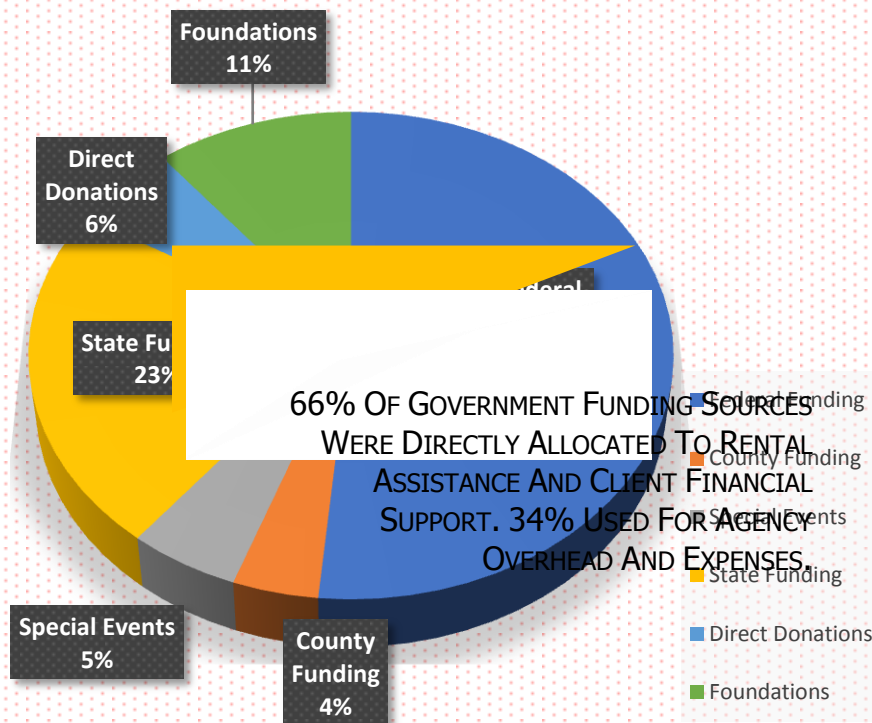
