Family Promise of Sussex County will now be serving clients at our new location at the Sussex United Methodist Church, 15 Bank Street, Sussex, NJ. Dropin hours are available for our clients on Mondays and Thursdays from 12:00pm until 4:00pm.

Clients can meet with caseworkers that will provide housing guidance and support during the drop-in hours.
Clients can also apply for LIHEAP. LIHEAP is a utility assistance program that helps with the costs of heating bills.





The Mobile Outreach Team will be available for assistance as well. This team can assist by providing access to needed resources, and can bring clients food, clothing, shelter resources, and mobile internet access. The team can also provide transportation to necessary appointments and can assist with benefits applications.

On Monday, August 7th, Family Promise of Sussex County was featured in the Nonprofit Spotlight. The teams were able to give distribute 141 agency information bags and inform fair goers about the agency.









Over the summer, Family Promise of Sussex County ran a fun summer program for our clients' children, called Summer of You. This program focused on learning how to cope with trauma in healthy ways, the importance of selfcare, engaging in emotional regulation, and practicing positive self-talk.

The program also featured The Champ Up Workshop from former professional Muay Thai Champion, coach and author, Chris Romulo. Chris's workshop focused on empowering the youth to embrace the spirit of a champion and had key speaking points that addressed overcoming adversity, bullying resilience, and the three steps to a champion's uprising.











The Financial Literacy class of FPSC was crafted to teach others how to improve one's relationship with money.

The classes encompassed topics on how to create a budget, manage finances, bill paying, ways to fix one's credit, needs vs. wants, and ways to save and invest.

Clients were also taught the importance of setting goals.

The Financial Literacy class was offered to all of our FPSC clients that were interested in taking the next step towards making a positive, healthier future with one's finances.

Family Promise of Sussex County attended Project Self Sufficiency's Back to School Night. We saw 400 families and were able to hand out flyers to those who may need our services. We also had a fun craft, paper kites!

At this event we were able to inform attendees about Family Promise and the services we provide. ## Family Promise Night without a Bed

Night Without A Bed is a campaign that raises awareness about family homelessness, a crists that affects more than 2 million children in this country every year. Imagine sleeping in your car and having to get ready for school or work. Or moving from one motel to another to have a roof overhead. Those are just some of the realities faced by families experiencing homelessness.

- 1 in 19 children experiences homelessness before entering the first grade.
- The number one cause of family homelessness is a lack of affordable housing. On average, there are only 33 affordable rentals available for every 100 extremely low-income households.
- Children who experience homelessness are at increased risk of academic failure and physical and mental health issues.
- Family homelessness is an invisible crisis. Ashamed of the stigma of homelessness, families often go out of their way to keep their situation hidden.
