June is National PTSD awareness Month. This month we are raising awareness of the lasting impact that the trauma of homelessness has on those who have lived through it.

Every day, we meet people who are not just facing housing instability, but also the overwhelming stress, fear, and isolation that often comes with it. That's why we approach every situation with compassion - because healing is just as important as housing.

At Family Promise of Sussex County, we provide services and resources that help stabilize housing such as emergency shelter, housing navigation, and case management. But we go beyond that with wraparound support that is designed to address deeper challenges that come with housing instability. This includes programs such as our Financial Literacy classes that provide our clients with the knowledge and tools to manage their finances and plan for long-term stability; and our utility assistance support through LIHEAP, which helps those struggling to pay their utility bill access critical energy assistance to keep their heating and electric on.

We see firsthand how trauma and homelessness are intertwined. That's why trauma-informed care is at the heart of what we do. This month - and every month - we recognize the strength it takes to rebuild after trauma, and we remain committed to providing the support needed for individuals and families.

We don't just help people find shelter - we walk alongside them as they rebuild their lives with stability, support, and hope.


June is National PTSD Awareness Month - a time to recognize the invisible wounds many people carry and to raise awareness about the effects of trauma on mental health.

While PTSD is often associated with those who've experienced violence or disaster, we must also acknowledge how deeply traumatic homelessness can be. Losing the safety and stability of a home doesn't just affect a person's physical well-being - it can leave lasting emotional and psychological scars.

For individuals and families, homelessness can mean:

- Constant uncertainty and fear
- Exposure to unsafe or unstable environments
- Separation from support systems
- A sense of shame, isolation, and anxiety

Children experiencing homelessness are especially vulnerable. The instability can disrupt their education, development, and sense of safety, often leading to long-term emotional and behavioral challenges.
